LOCATION – This is a bay tournament. No boundaries for fishing. You may launch from anywhere in Calhoun County. The post-tournament party will be at Port O'Conner Community Center.

TIMELINE -

- First Light 1:00 p.m. Anglers on water (must be in weigh-in line by 1:30 p.m.)
- 1:30 p.m. Anglers weigh-in at Port O'Conner Community Center
- 2 p.m. Angler lunch buffet open at Port O'Connor Community Center
- Award presentation during lunch

TEAM SIZE

4 angler maximum and 1 guide (Guide is optional and additional cost -credit cards accepted)

PRIZES AWARDED TO 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams

Combined Stringer- 2 Redfish (20"-28"), 1 trout (17"-23")

Fish can only be used one time.

TEAM COST

\$500 per team

OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT RULES

- Tournament Teams will consist of 1-4 people. Guides will not count as a team member.
 Only one team per boat.
- No Boundaries for fishing. You may launch anywhere in Calhoun County. Must be back at the Port O'Connor Community Center by 1:30 p.m. for weigh in.
- First cast time is "first light" time per weather apps.
- No sharing or pooling of fish with other teams and boats is allowed.
- All anglers must carry a valid Texas fishing license with a saltwater stamp. All federal, state and tournament rules will be abided by including valid fishing license.
- Live, dead or artificial bait is allowed.
- Combined stringer will consist of 2 slot redfish and 1 trout. No tagged redfish over 28" will be allowed. Trout must be between 17" and 23".
- Weigh master will have final say on eligibility on any fish brought to the scales. No pale, gilled, or mutilated fish will be allowed. Team will be disqualified. A trimmed tail is a mutilated fish. In the event of a tie in weight, the first team to weigh in will be winner.
- Weigh-in time will be at the Port O'Connor Community Center from 12-2p.m. Your team must be in line with your fish by 1:30pm sharp. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- The official clock will be "cellular phone" time and will be monitored by the weigh-in team.
- Teams must fish in public waters accessible to public fisherman.
- All fish must be caught by rod and reel in adherence to State Law on the day of the tournament.
- Tournament categories are: Combined Stringer- 2 Redfish (20"-28"), 1 trout (17"-23").
- Prizes will be awarded to 1st through 3rd place.
